TRUST DEED

THIS DEED OF TRUST IS MADE ON THIS 11th DAY OF MAY, 2024

Between

Sh. Vishal Atri s/o Sh. Sudesh Kumar Atri resident of House No. 128/811, Lane 13 -A Defence Colony, Ambala Cantt.-133001 here in after called Author/Founder & Trustee of the one part.

And

1. Mr. Yashwardhan Singh Atri S/o Sh. Vishal Atri resident of House No. 128/811 lane 13 A Defence Colony, Sector-D Kalarheri, Ambala Cantt.-133001
2. Mrs. Kavita Atri W/o Sh. Vishal Atri resident of House No. 128/811 lane 13 A Defence Colony, Sector-D Kalarheri, Ambala Cantt.-133001

HEREINAFTER CALLED THE "TRUSTEES" OF THE OTHERS PARTS.

Whereas the founder wishes to do charitable work by opening schools, Colleges and educational institutions, and doing other welfare tasks for the welfare of the general public to help the general public in good cause profession, get good education for their children, promote various individual in good public life, sponsor students for good education, in India and abroad.


AND WHEREAS the founder has donated a sum of Rs. 21,000/- upon trust to the trustees for the purpose of the trust called " SUDESH EDUCATIONAL TRUST " here in after described as TRUST.

AND WHEREAS the foundation trustees of the other part have agreed to be the trustees of the said TRUST and to accept and receive from the founder the said sum of Rs. 5,100/- in cash.

AND WHEREAS the founder has relinquished all the rights and interest and claim in the said sum of Rs. 5,100/- given by him towards the corpus of the said TRUST.

NOW THIS DEED OF THE TRUST WITNESSETH AS UNDER

- I. That the founder hereby assigns and pays the said sum of Rs. 21,000/- in favour of " SUDESH EDUCATIONAL TRUST " for carrying out the object here in after mentioned to the founder – Trustees. The said amount of Rs. 5,100/- paid by the founder has been accepted by the Founder Trustees and the same is and shall hereinafter by the corpus, property and asset of the TRUST.
- II. That the trust shall be known as "SUDESH EDUCATIONAL TRUST" and will have its Registered Office at House No. 128/811, lane 13 A Defence Colony, Sector-D, Kalarheri, Ambala Cantt. or any other place as the trustees may here in after mutually decide.
- III. That the TRUST fund shall be the said amount Rs. 5,100/- to begin with and shall include all acquisition/contributions, donations, bequests whether in cash, kind or movable properties in favour of TRUST.

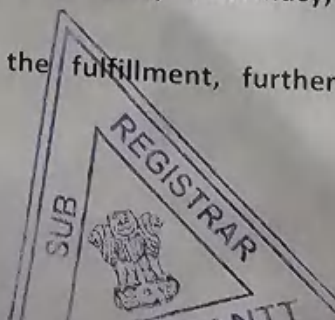


OBJECTS OF THE TRUST

The objects for which the TRUST has been created are inter alia to provide, set up, establish run schools, colleges and other educational institutions/ centre for the welfare of the general public to get good education for their children, promote various individuals in good public life, sponsor students for good education in India and abroad.

- (a) To establish, maintain and run Schools, Colleges, Educational Institutions, Industrial Training centre and to get them affiliated to various Government, Non Government Indian and International accrediting organizations Boards or organizations & run by Lease agreement.
- (b) To establish Training Centre and allied education institutions.
- (c) To establish Culture and Social Institutions
- (d) To spread for promotion of education and learning in all branches more specifically in Languages, Arts, Science and Technology.
- (e) To advance Indian Culture and Literature for the benefit of the Nation.
- (f) To train teachers and worker in ideals and practice of the true spirit of the education and learning.
- (g) To establish research and training centre of the furtherance of education/learning in Its various fields and branches.
- (h) To undertake propaganda, training and education of the masses either of its own or in co-operation with similar agencies working for the cause of all round development of the society.
- (i) To bring , publish and sell, distribute books, periodicals, leaflets, brochures and papers and also to open and maintain libraries, reading rooms for the promotion of the objects of the Trust.
- (j) To function as a Non-communal Trust and as a secular organization.
- (k) To establish centre for employment generation.
- (l) To acquire or on lease agreement and maintain the movables and immovable properties for achieving the said objects.
- (m) To advance any other objects of general public utility.
- (n) To confer title on eminent personality in the field of science, education, literature etc.
- (o) To establish the colleges to impart education in the area of higher education especially the emerging field like, Electronics, Bio-technology, Medicine, Pharmacy, Artificial Intelligence and other allied fields.
- (p) To encourage and actively involve public for the fulfillment, furtherance and achievement of the object of the TRUST.



(q) To pursue in the general interest of the public and conduct itself on a non profit ,non political, non sectarian and non religious basis.

(r) To offer prizes and to grant scholarship, endowment, grant and assistance in all forms and stipends in furtherance of the object of the TRUST and to do, or get done, all such other lawful things as are conducive or incidental to the attainment of the above objects.

(s) To arouse public opinion and to make Governmental as well as other public or private authorities aware of these functions and for this purpose to open chapters in different part of the country, to promote the objectives of the TRUST.

(t) To establish sponsor, administer and provide funds stipends, scholarships and study grants to enable deserving and/or meritorious students to pursue their studies and training in all fields.

(u) To do all such other acts and things as are incidental or as the Trust may consider necessary or desirable or conducive to the attainment of the above object or any of them.

(v) To subscribe to become a member of or otherwise co-operate with any other association or associations or in part similar to those of the TRUST.

(w) To make rules and bye-laws from time and repel or a held the same as and when required.

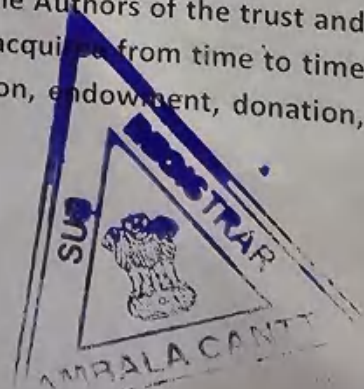

(x) To do all or any of the above things through the executive committee , its agents or otherwise , either alone or in conjunction with others.

(y) To do all such other things as are incidental or conducive to the attainment of the above objects, or any of them.

(z) To invest, dispose of, transfer or otherwise deal with the subject matter of the TRUST in such manner as the trustee should deem fit so as to enable the TRUST to carry on its object effectively.

It is mutually considered that the objects of the TRUST will be better achieved if the income of the TRUST is exempt under the income tax act. In case , however any particular clause or clauses of the instrument of TRUST have been inadvertently clothed in a language capable of interpretation in conflict with the relevant income tax provisions granting exemption, it is hereby agreed that such clause or clauses will have restricted meanings so that the relevant income tax provisions will always have the overriding effect for availing exemption under the Income tax Act.

The trust shall be an irrevocable public educational, culture trust for the benefit of all persons belonging to whatever community irrespective of Caste, Creed or Religion, the TRUSTEES shall stand possessed of the said amount of corpus endowed by the Authors of the trust and such other properties (both movable and immovable) as may be acquired from time to time by the Trust, by purchase, exchange, grant, allotment, subscription, endowment, donation,



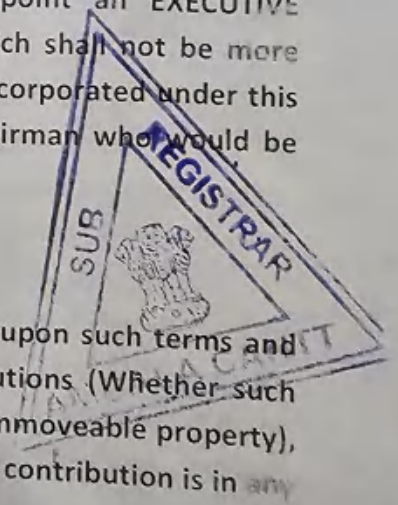

contribution, or in any manner to whatsoever (all of which shall be designed as Trust properties) on the Trust herein mentioned.

CONSTITUTION OF THE TRUST

1. The total number of trustees at any time shall not be less than two and not more than twenty.
2. i) The above named Founder-Trustees shall form the first board of trustee who will appoint the Vice- chairman and General Secretary .
ii) There may be provision for Chief Patron, Patron, Chief Chairman, Vice Chairman .
3. i) The founder trustees as appearing under this deed aforesaid will remain in office and continue to function as trustees during their life time unless any of them dies or voluntarily resigns or retires or is declared of unsound mind by a court of competent jurisdiction or adjudged insolvent or convicted for any offence involving moral turpitude or otherwise becomes incapable of acting as a trustee. In such event the remaining trustees will appoint in place of such outgoing trustee or trustees, person of their choice to replace them and the person so appointed shall function and hold office in the same manner if they were the founder Trustees fo all intention and purposes. The consent of the discerdents of **SUDESH EDUCATIONAL TRUST** would be necessary for such appointments.
ii) It is hereby decreed that at least two of the trustee on the board of the foundation would be direct discerdents of **SUDESH EDUCATIOANL TRUST**.
4. The founder – Trustees shall always remain on the board of the TRUST. Founder-Trustees above shall always have the power to appoint/nominate other trustees. The Nominated Trustees shall always retires at the Annual General Meeting of the TRUST (or as may be decided by the Founder-trustees) to be reappointed if thought necessary by the Founder – Trustees.
5. The Board of the Trustees shall have the powers to appoint an EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE if thought expedient, to administer the trust which shall not be more than twenty persons including the Founder- Trustees so first incorporated under this trust deed. The Executive committee shall be guided by a chairman who would be appointed by the trustees.

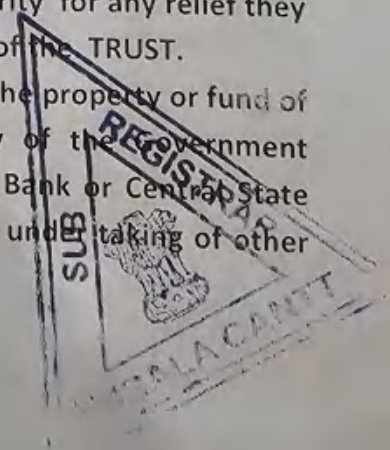

POWERS OF THE TRUSTEES

- (i) The trustees shall have the power and discretion to accept upon such terms and conditions as they may think fit any donations or contributions (Whether such donations or contributions be is cash or other moveable or immoveable property), provided always that the terms upon which such donation or contribution is in any



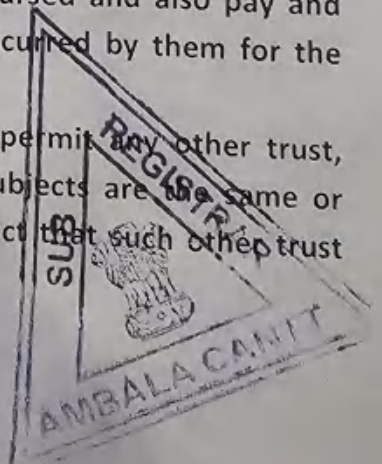

way be inconsistent with or repugnant to the objects of these presents and if any conditions are attached to any such donations or contributions the same shall be treated as having being given or made for the furtherance of the objects of these presents.

- (ii) It shall be lawful for the Board of Trustees to settle and determine all matter interpretation of these presents, as well as all matters of difficulty, doubt or dispute, and all questions arising in the course of or incidental to the administration, management and execution of the Trusts and powers of these presents, and any such settlement or determination (although the question involved may not have been raised shall be valid, binding and conclusive and shall not be objected to or reopened upon any ground whatsoever.
- (iii) The Board of Trustees shall have full power to settle, compromise or compound out of court, all suits, actions and other proceedings and to settle all differences and demands and to refer any or all of such suits, actions or other proceedings differences or demands to arbitration to adjust and settle all accounts relating to the Trust Funds and property and to execute releases and to do all things relating there to as fully as if they were absolutely entitled to the Trust Fund and without being answerable for any loss occasioned thereby.
- (iv) The Board Trustees shall be entitled to acquire construct purchase, hire to take lease a property or properties for the purpose of carrying out the objects of the TRUST thereby created.
- (v) The Board Trustees may, from time to time , at their discretion and for the furtherance of the objects of this TRUST borrow moneys at such rates of the interest and in such from and manner and upon security as shall be specified in resolution and in pursuance thereof make all such disposition of the properties moveable or immoveable forming part of this TRUST Fund or any part thereof, and enter into such agreements, assurances, deeds and things in relation there to as the Board of Trustees may deem proper for giving security for such loans interests.
- (vi) The chairman and the executive committee or any person authorized shall by a resolution of the Board of Trustees have the power to institute in the name of this TRUST all legal proceedings, sign all legal and other documents relating to the property of this TRUST, in any court of law tribunal or authority for any relief they think fit for the furtherance of the objects and the activities of the TRUST.
- (vii) (a) Board of Trustees shall invest all money forming part of the property or fund of this TRUST and not required for immediate use in any of the Government securities or in fixed deposit with scheduled or Chartered Bank or Central State or District Co-operative banks in India or in a Public Sector undertakings of other

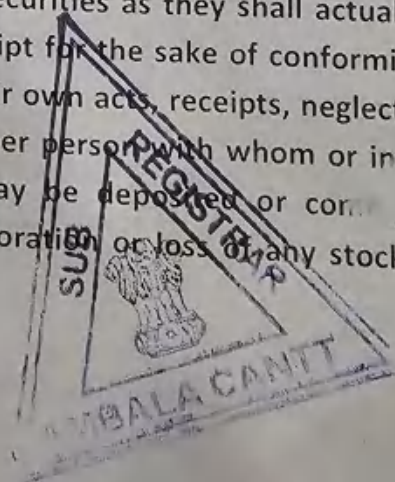



financial institutions approved for the investment of Trust Funds by the Govt. The trustees shall have the power to vary from time to time or transpose the aforesaid investments into others of the same or like or others of the same or like or other nature.

- (b) The Board of Trustees shall invest the surplus fund with the TRUST in accordance with the guidelines issued by the (ii) of the Income Tax act.
- (vii) The Trustees may as per resolution recorded in writing, open and maintain in the name of this TRUST any bank account or Bank accounts with such scheduled or chartered Bank or Bank or Central, state or District co-operative Bank of Banks as may from time to time be determined by them, shall forthwith pay or cause to be paid the rents, income, profits, dividends and shall all other moneys forming part of this TRUST Fund to the Credit of any such account or accounts, Such account or accounts shall be operated upon jointly by at least two of the office bearers of this TRUST Such account or accounts can also be closed by the Trustees, if any.
- (viii) The trustees shall have the power to sell or assign any immovable or moveable properties for the time being forming part of this TRUST property, either together or in parcels in any manner they deem fit.
- (ix) The receipt in writing of the Chairman or the Executive Committee or any person authorized by the Resolution of the Board of Trustees for any interest, dividend of income of this TRUST property or for any deeds, papers, writing documents or other moneys and effects payable or deliverable to the Trustees shall be a sufficient and effectual discharge for the same respectively as in such receipt or receipts shall expressed or acknowledged to be or to have been received.
- (x) The Board of Trustees shall, from time to time be entitled to make Rules and Regulations, alter , amend , substitute or delete them for the administration and management of the TRUST of these presents and all matters incidental to or concerning the same, provided such Rules and regulations shall not be repugnant to, offend against or be inconsistent with the provisions of the purpose of the TRUST thereof.
- (xi) The Trustees of these presents are entitled to be reimbursed and also pay and discharge out of the TRUST fund for all the expenses incurred by them for the works of the TRUST.
- (xii) The board of Trustees shall be at liberty to allow and permit any other trust, institutions charity, in any local area or areas, whose subjects are the same or similar to those of these presents to the indent and effect that such other trust



- institutions or society shall be deemed to be a part and parcel of the trust of these presents provided that no conditions are accepted which are inconsistent with or repugnant to the objects thereof.
- (xiii) The Board of Trustees shall be free to decide to achieve the objects of the TRUST and any one or more of the following methods:
- (a) By amalgamating, merging or collaborating with any society established under the society registration act of 1860 and which has the same or subsequently similar objects the TRUST shall agree to amalgamation or merger into such a society on condition that all the trustees of the trust become members of such Society.
 - (b) To request respectable persons and to associate respectable persons for establishing a society under the Societies Registration act of 1860 with the same objectives as are the objectives of this TRUST and to administer this TRUST through the instrumentality of such a society in such manner as the trustees may decide while keeping individually and existence of the TRUST also alive the trustees may decide as to the extend of funds to be released in favour of such a society from time to time for achievement for the object of the TRUST. If and when such a society is established and before the trustees administered objects of this Trust through the instrumentality of this society the trustees shall ensure that they become the founder members of such society along with such other persons as may desire to establish such society.
 - (c) The Trustees shall also be free to decide to incorporate a Company Limited by guarantee or otherwise with the same objectives as of the TRUST and may also decide whether to merger itself into such a company or to use such a company as a instrumentality as its objects.
- (xiv) The Trustees may delegate any of their powers to one or more Trustees out of themselves or to the executive committee by a former resolution to be recorded in writing after the same is passed at a meeting held by them or through circulation.
- (xv) The board of Trustees for the time being of these presents shall be chargeable only for such moneys, stocks, funds deposits and securities as they shall actually receive, not with standing their signing of any receipt for the sake of conformity and shall be answerable or accountable only for their own acts, receipts, neglects, defaults and not for those of each other or any other person with whom or into whose hands the TRUST money or securities may be deposited or committed in accordance with these presents nor for the deterioration or loss of any stocks,



funds, deposits or securities nor for any defect or insufficiency of title nor for any other losses unless the same shall happen through their own willful default.

RULES AND REGULATIONS OF MEETINGS OF THE TRUSTEES

1. There shall be held every year, within six months of the closing of accounts of the TRUST, a meeting of the board Trustees which shall be called "Annual Meeting" to transact the following business:
 - i. To adopt the Annual report and the Audited accounts of the Trust Fund.
 - ii. To elect Executive Committee, office bearers when necessary.
 - iii. To appoint auditors for the ensuing year and
 - iv. To transact such other business as is required under these presents or Rules and Regulations to be transacted at an Annual Meeting.
2. The General Secretary or any other appointed office bearer in consultation with the Chairperson, shall convene a meeting (called ordinary) of the board of trustees to transact such business as he may decide to place before the meeting and shall on the requisition At least two Trustees for the time being, of these presents specifying the business for the meeting proceed to convene a special meeting of the board of Trustees to consider the business specified in the requisition.

NOTICE OF THE MEETING

3. A meeting of the Board of Trustees, whether annual, ordinary or special may be called on not less than fourteen clear days notice in writing,
4. A notice of the meeting of the Board of Trustees, whether annual, ordinary or special specifying the place day and hour with the brief statement of the business to be transacted at the meeting shall be sent to every Trustees by post or in such manner as may from time to time be decided.

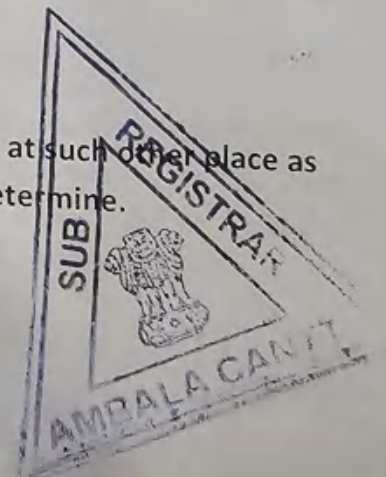

OMMISSION TO GIVE NOTICE

5. The accidental omission to give notice or the non receipt thereof shall not be invalidate the proceedings at any such meeting.

WHERE MEETING TO BE HELD

6. Such meetings may be held at the Head office of the Trust or at such other place as the Chairman or Secretary General may from time to time Determine.

WHO IS TO CHAIR THE MEETING



7. The chairman of the Board of Trustees and in his absence the one person amongst the Board of Trustees shall preside at all meeting of the Board of Trustees.

QUORUM

8. At least one third or two of the trustees for the time being of these presents, whichever is more in number shall form the quorum for the meeting of the Trustees, whether Annual, Ordinary or special.

NO TRANSACTION OF BUSINESS WITHOUT QUORUM

9. No business shall be transacted at the meeting of the Trustees, Whether Annual, ordinary or special unless the requisite for quorum be present.

WHEN QUORUM NOT PRESENT

10. If within half an hour from the time appointed for a meeting a quorum is not present the meeting shall stand adjourned to such time as the Chairperson of the meeting shall determine and if at such adjourned meeting a quorum is not present, the meeting may be re-scheduled. It shall also be necessary to give notice to the Trustees of any such adjourned meeting.

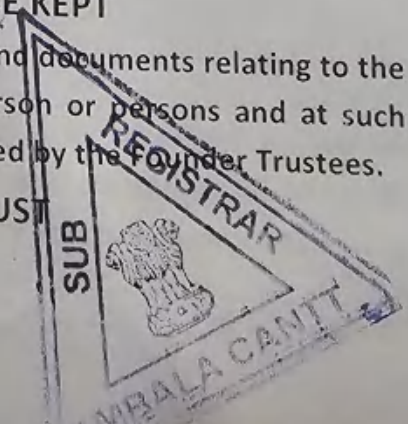

RESOLUTION OF THE TRUSTEES BY CIRCULAR

11. In case of urgency the chairman are at his/her instance a member of the board of Trustees may circulated any proposal that may arise in the course of the administration of the trusts of these presents for the opinion of the Trustees giving minutes as time for the receipt of the opinion from the date of the dispatch of the proposal. If no dissent to the proposal contained in such circular is received within the stipulated period, the proposal shall be deemed to have been passed provided at least one third of the Trustees or shall have voted in writing for the proposal. All decisions taken by the circular shall forthwith be reported in writing to all the trustees and shall be placed at the following meeting of the Board of Trustees for information.

RECORDS, ETC., WHERE TO BE KEPT

12. All records , title deeds, securities, vouchers, papers and documents relating to the TRUST fund shall remain in gen custody of such person or persons and at such place or places as may from time to time be determined by the Founder Trustees.

HEAD OFFICE OF THE TRUST



13. The head office of the trust shall be situated in 128/811, Lane 13- A Defence Colony Ambala Cantt or at such other place as may from time to time be determined by the Founder Trustees.

POWER TO APPOINT SUB COMMITTEES AND TO DELEGATE

14. The board of trustees may delegate any of their powers to the executive committee, sub committee consisting of such members of their body as they think fit. Any such working board of government or Sub-committee so formed shall in the exercise of the power so delegated conform to any regulations that may from time to time, be imposed upon it by the trustees. It is hereby clarified that the board of Trustees shall be final authority for all matters concerning the TRUST. In case of clarification or dispute the authority of the board of Trustees shall be final & binding on the Board Governors or any such sub- committee.

PROCEEDINGS OF SUB COMMITTEES

15. The meetings and proceedings of any working of executive committee, sub-committee shall be governed by the provisions herein contained for regulating the meetings and proceedings of the board of Trustees so far as the same are applicable there to and are not superseded by the regulations made by the Board of Trustees under the last preceding clause.

QUESTIONS HOW TO BE DECIDED


16. Questions arising at the meeting of the Board of Trustees shall be decided by the show of hands and in case of equality of votes, the Chairman of the meeting shall have the second or casting vote.

BOOKS OF ACCOUNTS

17. The board of Trustees shall cause to be kept proper books of the accounts with respect to all sums of money received and expended on account of the TRUST of these presents and the matter in respect of which such receipt and expenditure take place. The books of account shall be kept at the head office of the institute or at such other place or places as may from time to time be determined by the board of Trustees.

ANNUAL AUDIT

18. The board of trustees shall have in each accounting year, after the closing of accounts, made and prepared all proper accounts of receipts and expenditure in connection with the management of the affairs of the institute here to showing



the same separately under several heads and such accounts shall be audited by a duly qualified Chartered Accountant appointed every year and only after such accounts are passed at the AGM of the Trustees shall they be made public.

The first shall auditors shall be appointed in the first board meeting or any further such meeting desired by the board.

MINUTES

19. The Board of Trustees and the Executive Committee shall minutes to be duly entered in the books provided for the purpose :
- i. Of all resolution and decisions of the meetings of the Trustees and matters disposed of by circulation.
 - ii. Of all resolutions and decide as of the meetings of any sub-committee appointed by the Trustees.

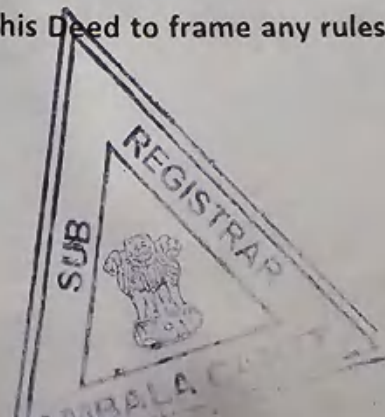
MINUTES CONCLUSIVE EVIDENCE

20. The Draft minutes of proceedings of meeting of the Board of Trustees, Executive Committee or of sub- committee shall in the first instance be circulated amongst the Trustees or the members of the sub-committee as the case may be and subject to any direction by the chairman in respect of any suggestions or alterations in the draft that may be received within the fortnight from the date of such circulation, the minutes may be caused to be entered in the respective minute books. Any such minutes of any meeting of the board of Trustees or any committee or sub-committee if purporting to be signed by the chairperson of such meeting or by the chairman of the next succeeding meeting shall be conclusive evidence of the matters, stated in such minutes. The trustees have consented to discharge their responsibilities as trustees under the deed.

MEMBERS

It is clarified that all such members shall not acquire any right in this TRUST merely by being members. They shall not be entitled to call for meetings or elect any office bearers to administer the Trust which function shall be discharged by the board of trustees alone.

The founder trustees are fully empowered under this Deed to frame any rules and regulation for administering this TRUST.
